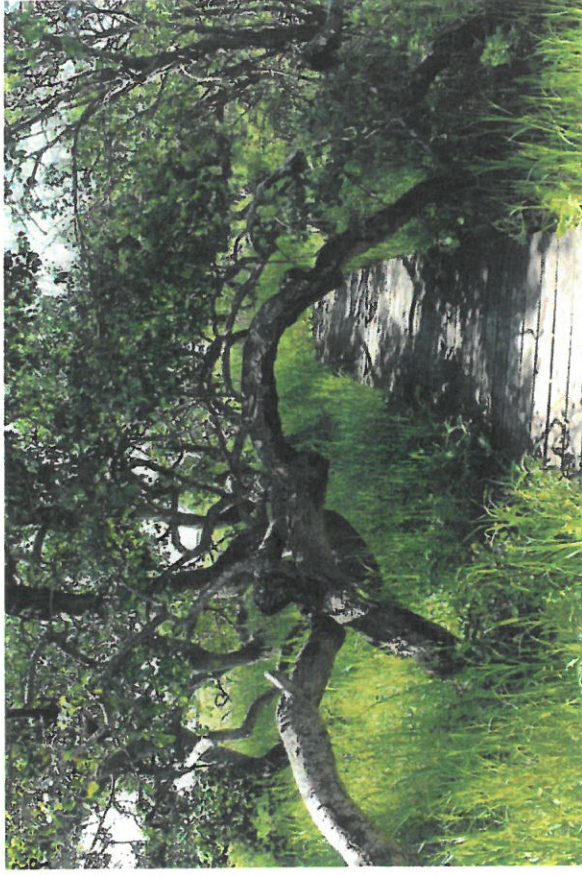

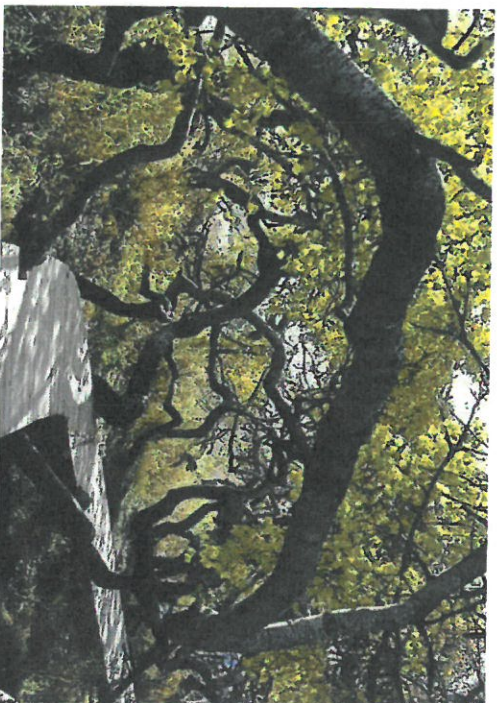

The Crooked Bush !

What is the “Crooked Bush” ?

The Crooked Bush is a grove of wild aspen trees which do not grow straight up as normal aspens do, but have rather twisted, looped and bent into the eeriest of forests. Not ten meters away from the Crooked Bush is a normal aspen grove in which the trees grow straight and tall.



University research has concluded – all but definitively – that these trees grow in their crooked form as a result of genetic mutation. The catch, of course, is... *what caused the mutation originally?* There is much folklore around the neighbourhood (and beyond!) proposing the initial cause, but nobody seems to know for certain.

Locals know, however, that a full moon lights up the Crooked Bush in a very special way. Indeed, it requires an iron will and courage of stone to visit the Crooked Bush at night!

We also know you will enjoy visiting this incredible phenomenon, whenever you come!

Directions to the Crooked Bush from Hafford:

Go West 14.5 km on Highway 40, past the turnoff to Speers, then turn **right** onto the Flint Road.

Go **North** on the Flint Road 16 km (10 miles)

Turn **right** at the intersection and travel East 2.5 km (1.5 miles).

The Crooked Trees will be on your **right** (South side of road).
